Frequently Asked Questions

Does Childreach International check that participating children have permission from their parent or legal guardian to take part in events?

For participants under the age of 18, Childreach International requires written permission from a participant's parent or legal guardian allowing them to take part in any given event. A signed copy of this form must be submitted to Childreach International to validate the online application to the programme.

Is there a minimum age for street or house-to-house fundraising?

The minimum age for street or house-to-house fundraising is 16 years of age.

Are there any special safety measures that need to be followed if children are involved in fundraising activities?

Childreach International asks for the support of parents and teachers to keep children safe. Please explain and ensure the following safety measures are adhered to:

Children must be aware that they are not allowed to approach strangers for money and that to go knocking from door-to-door is against the law.

Children must understand that they are only allowed to approach friends and relatives for sponsorship. Please help give your children/pupils examples of 'safe sponsors.'
